Welcome New Employees Two seasonal CCMA park rangers have been hired. We now have four full time law enforcement rangers.

<u>Federal Lands Recreation</u> Enhancement Act (FLREA)

Under FLREA, before BLM can start charging fees to the public, a Recreation Resource Advisory Committee (RECRAC) will be formed and each site shall go through a review process to approve/disapprove a new fee program. California now has at least one applicant for each of the 11 seats on the RECRAC. A screening panel will be set up in January and a qualified list will be referred by the panel to Mike Pool, BLM-California's State Director and Bernie Weingardt, USFS Pacific Southwest Regional Forester for selection.
