A fencing work party is scheduled for Sunday, December 19 to continue construction of a resource protection fence in Upper Clear Creek Canyon.

Please meet at 9 am at Oak Flat Campground. Bring water, food, warm clothing, sturdy work boots, work gloves, and any other personal items. The project involves a 1 mile hike up the creek to access the site.

Asbestos Alert

Office of Safety & Health Administration (OSHA) policy regards exposure to asbestos of levels at or above 0.1 fibers per cubic centimeter within an 8-hour period may pose a potential hazard to human health.

Latest air sample readings: .005, .005, .030, .016 Readings vary depending on the nature of the activity during sampling. Parts of the CCMA recently received nearly four inches of rainfall which has helped reduce dusty conditions. OSHA recommends wearing a respirator if air samples exceed .10 in the CCMA.

Note that operating motorcycles and ATV's can generate significantly higher asbestos concentrations.

Did you know that there are many plants that grow only in serpentine soils? Now your questions can be answered by BLM staff at the entrance to Clear Creek during weekends starting this winter.

Limit discharge of firearms to areas outside Clear Creek Canyon. Always think of where your shot may end up.

BLM is planning additional resource protection fencing for the "Jade Mill" area between Oak Flats and Staging Area One. Contact the Hollister Field office for more information.

EPA Risk Assessment

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has conducted air sampling within Clear Creek to determine personal exposure levels of asbestos during various activities. This information will be presented to BLM and the public, and could result in the Atlas Mine site being removed from EPAs "Superfund" list.
